

## COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE LEVY

AN OPEN MEETING FOR ALL RESIDENTS OF SOUTH LUFFENHAM WAS HELD ON SUNDAY 29<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2018 IN THE VILLAGE HALL.

IT WAS HELD TO INFORM THE VILLAGERS OF THE ROLES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL AND THE COUNTY COUNCIL.

VACANCIES ON THE PARISH COUNCIL WERE ADVERTISED AND A PARISH SURVEY WAS HANDED OUT ASKING FOR RESIDENTS VIEWS ON HOW THEY WOULD LIKE TO SEE SOUTH LUFFENHAM IN 5-10 YEARS.

THE PARISH COUNCIL HAD BEEN GIVEN A DISBURSEMENT £2,610.00 FROM THE COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE LEVY (THIS IS COLLECTED FROM ANY DEVELOPMENT CARRIED OUT IN THE VILLAGE, AND CAN BE USED FOR A BROAD RANGE OF FACILITIES)

RESIDENTS WERE ASKED WHAT THEY WOULD LIKE TO SEE THE MONEY USED FOR. SUGGESTIONS WERE:-

REFURBISHMENT OF THE OLD CRICKET PAVILION OR A CAR STANDING AREA ON THE RECREATION GROUND (THIS WILL BE DONE VIA A GRANT)

PINFOLD LANE LAYBY (IS INCLUDED IN THE CAPITAL TRANSPORT SCHEME AND WILL BE CARRIED OUT BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL)

REFURBISHMENT OF VILLAGE SIGN AND MOVING IT TO A NEW LOCATION

A NEW VILLAGE NOTICEBOARD TO REPLACE THE ONE ON PINFOLD LANE.

IT WAS AGREED IN THE END TO PURCHASE A NEW NOTICEBOARD MADE FROM ALUMINIUM AND PAINTED GREEN. THIS WILL REQUIRE MINIMUM MAINTENANCE FOR THE NEXT 25 YEARS

THE COST OF THE NOTICEBOARD INCLUDING DELIVERY AND INSTALLATION IS £2,075.00 LEAVING A RESIDUE OF £535.00 WHICH WILL BE USED FOR EITHER PURCHASING A NEW LITTER BIN OR PAVING SLABS TO IMPROVE ACCESS ON THE VILLAGE GREEN LEADING TO THE TELEPHONE BOX WHICH HOUSES THE DEFIBRILLATOR.
